The proof of the highest education level achieved provided (for Bachelor's degree applicants - high school diploma; for Master's degree applicants, Bachelor's degree diploma; and for Ph.D. degree applicants, Master's degree diploma) is valid and legally awarded in the country from which I was graduated. The diploma provided is equivalent to the degree conferred by accredited schools and universities in Taiwan.
